<b>Awards</b>	Ribbons for 1 <sup>st</sup> to 6 <sup>th</sup> Places and End of Show Championships.
<b>End of Show Championships</b>	There must be at least four (4) riders competing in a division for an End of Show Championship for that division to be offered, and each horse/rider combination must have scores in no less than two classes per division to qualify for a championship. High % calculated by average of tests ridden per horse/rider combination in each division. Overall High % will go to the individual with the highest % scored of the day.
